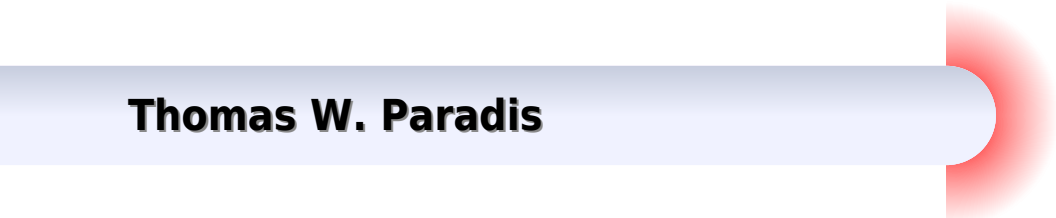


The Hunger Games Journal Prompts
