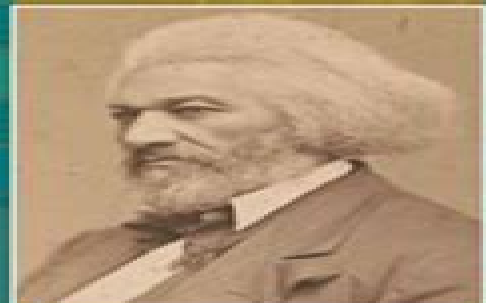

his literary abilities Tying these diverse threads together Chandler demonstrates the power of the black narrative to assimilate and redeploy the literary trope of wanderlust exchanging its premise of rootless drifting for something altogether more mobilizing
