American Sublime Rob Wilson, 1991 Tracing ideas of the sublime in American literature from Puritan writings to the postmodern epoch Rob Wilson demonstrates that the North American landscape has been the ground for political as well as aesthetic transport He takes a distinctly historical approach and explores the ways in which experiences of the American landscape instill desire for other kinds of vastness self expansion national expansion and American political power As Wallace Stevens put it the American will takes dominion everywhere Wilson sets the stage for his genealogy with a discussion of the classical notion of the sublime taken primarily from Longinus and the ways that notion was pragmatically transformed by its American setting and appropriated by American poets He follows this transformation in successive chapters on the Puritans Bradstreet through the Naturalists Livingston and Bryant from the epitome of the American sublime Whitman to the greatest of the modernists Stevens and its present day incarnations Ashbery and others Writing today under the sign of Hiroshima contemporary writers must struggle with the concept of the sublime within a context of spiralling technologies and nuclear force that calls into question the long standing American sacralization of power Throughout American Sublime Wilson engages in an original theoretical inquiry into the sublime as term topic complex and controversial idea in literary and critical history Furthermore he undertakes his historical study from an avowedly postmodern perspective one that draws on and extends the work of Jameson Lyotard Foucault Lentricchia Harold Bloom and others

The Collected Poems of Robert Penn Warren Robert Penn Warren, 1998-10-01 Winner of the C Hugh Holman Award A central figure in twentieth century American literature Robert Penn Warren 1905 1989 was appointed by the Library of Congress as the first Poet Laureate of the United States in 1985 Although better known for his fiction especially his novel *All the King's Men* it is mainly his poetry spanning sixty years fifteen volumes of verse and a wide range of styles that reveals Warren to be one of America's foremost men of letters In this indispensable volume John Burt Warren's literary executor has assembled every poem Warren ever published with the exception of *Brother to Dragons* including the many poems he published in *The Fugitive* and other magazines as well as those that appeared in his small press works and broadsides Burt has also exhaustively collated all of the published versions of Warren's poems which in some cases appeared as many as six different times with substantive revisions in every line as well as his typescripts and proofs And since Warren never seemed to reread any of his books without a pencil in his hand Burt has referred to Warren's personal library copies This comprehensive edition also contains textual notes lists of emendations and explanatory notes Warren was born and raised in Guthrie Kentucky where southern agrarian values and a predilection for storytelling were ingrained in him as a young boy By 1925 when he graduated from Vanderbilt University he was already the most promising of that exceptional set of poets and intellectuals known as the Fugitives Warren devoted most of the 1940s and 1950s to writing prose and literary criticism but from the late 1950s he composed primarily poetry with each successive volume of verse that he penned demonstrating his rigorous and growing commitment to that genre The mature visionary power and technical virtuosity of his work in the 1970s and early 1980s emanated from his strongly held belief that only insofar as the work of art establishes and expresses a self can it engage us Many of Warren's later poems which he deemed some of my best rejoice in the possibilities of old age and the poet's ability for continually expanding in a vital process of definition affirmation revision and growth a process that is the image we may say of the life process

Quotation and Modern American Poetry Elizabeth Gregory, 1996-07 In this volume Elizabeth Gregory addresses a number of key issues

surrounding the formation of the American poetic canon Taking as her primary examples T S Eliot s Waste Land William Carlos Williams Paterson and selected poems by Marianne Moore she examines the ways in which modern American writers struggled with questions of literary authority and cultural identity in relation to pre existing European models Gregory focuses on these issues through analysis of the use of quotation in modern and postmodern literature a practice that was strikingly divergent from the accepted use of literary allusion Her introduction traces a history of quotation as it has been practiced in literature from classical to modern times She then focuses on the texts of Eliot Williams and Moore three central figures of American modernism whose work the author believes represents a spectrum of responses to the established European model of poetical discourse Gregory s selection of Moore also allows her to deal with feminist concerns as they emerge in the more general modernist dialogue How was a female writer to make use of a literary canon that traditionally excluded female participation The implications of Gregory s argument will surely be of especial interest to feminist scholars of American poetry Lois Parkinson Zamora University of Houston

Marc Hempel, 2011-03 Seminar paper from the year 2010 in the subject English Language and Literature Studies Literature grade 2.0 RWTH Aachen University Institut für Anglistik Amerikanistik und Romanistik course Modern and Contemporary American Poetry language English abstract The current President of the United States of America Barack Obama was one of the few who in his inauguration ceremony in January 2009 had a poet read an inaugural poem This delightful tradition that had only been included by three presidents before but that in many ways supports and promotes the art of contemporary American poets was kept alive by Elizabeth Alexander one of the best known and most successful recent African American women poets Her Praise Song For The Day despite some sporadic criticism was a suitable and thoughtful composition for this occasion and it was then that I heard for the first time of Elizabeth Alexander an African American poet Her work and background fascinated me especially because she is a contemporary and her work is so recent and still going on Therefore I decided to examine four of her poems in the term paper at hand Emancipation Ars Poetica 28 African Leave Taking Disorder Race and Ars Poetica 92 Marcus Garvey on Elocution During my research I had to learn that sadly there is a significant lack of research and literature on this and other contemporary authors and therefore this term paper largely consists of my own findings regarding the poems Due to the reason that her personal background and her life have influenced the poems to a notable extent I will start off with a short biographical section on Elizabeth Alexander herself and point out further biographical traits while interpreting the poems in their respective chapters I will finally summarize my findings and present my personal conclusion as regards her way of tackling her topics and her art of writing
