Caribbean Modernist Architecture Gustavo Luis Moré, 2010 In February and March 2008 the International Program and the Department of Architecture and Design at The Museum of Modern Art organised the Museum's first symposium on the modernist architecture of the Caribbean and bordering Latin American countries in collaboration with the Caribbean School of Architecture at the University of Technology Kingston Jamaica The goal was to encourage scholarly curatorial and broader educational awareness Topics covered included regional and international legacies preservation environmental sustainability and urban planning as they relate to modernist architectural history and contemporary practice The presenters were leading architects and architectural historians from the region and attendees included their colleagues as well as local and international university students policy makers civic leaders and developers from Jamaica the surrounding Caribbean islands and the United States This illustrated volume co published by MoMA and Archivos de Arquitectura Antillana AAA an architectural journal based in the Dominican Republic presents the papers from this critical symposium in both English and Spanish making them accessible to a broader public

Expo 67 and Its World Craig Moyes, Steven Palmer, 2022-06-17 In 1967 Montreal hosted Man and His World Terre des hommes By far the most successful cultural event ever produced in Canada it was embraced by the public at the same time as intellectuals from Marshall McLuhan to Umberto Eco hailed it as a new type of exhibition for a new global age Because it was held where and when it was on a man made archipelago in the St Lawrence River seven years into Quebec's Quiet Revolution Expo 67 also provided a prism through which the idea of the nation could be refracted and recast in original ways Misunderstood by some scholars as an expensive exercise in official patriotism while maligned by Quebec intellectuals as a crypto federalist distraction from the real business of national independence the fair nevertheless showcased Montreal as the de facto capital of a suddenly modern Quebec engaging with a late modern world Expo 67 and Its World proposes a reappraisal of the 1967 Montreal International and Universal Exhibition across a range of

political social and cultural spaces from the dispossession of Indigenous Peoples and what was then known as the Third World through the aspirations of Montreal Quebec and Canada to the increasingly global ambit of youth culture medicine film and finance A new approach to understanding Expo 67 the collection challenges assumptions about the significance of the event to Canadian Qu b cois and First Nations history Revolution of Forms John A. Loomis,1999 A revolution of forms is a revolution of essentials Jos Mart Cuban intellectual and independence leader Although the current surge of interest in Cuba has extended to that country s architecture few know that the most outstanding architectural achievement of the Cuban Revolution stands neglected just outside Havana The Escuelas Nacionales de Arte National Art Schools constructed from 1961 to 1965 were the result of an educational program initiated by Fidel Castro and Che Guevara soon after the Revolution of 1959 The architects they commissioned created an organic complex of brick and terra cotta Catalan vaulted structures that reflected the optimism and exuberance of the period The schools attempted to reinvent architecture just as the Revolution hoped to reinvent society However even before construction was completed the schools fell out of official favor and were subjected to an attack that resulted in their subsequent disappearance An ideological campaign branded them politically incorrect a bourgeois luxury that was not in keeping with the Revolution The buildings fell into disuse and abandoned to the jungle were literally overgrown Now almost 40 years later Cuba is beginning to recognize and reclaim these significant works of architecture Revolution of Forms investigates the history and politics surrounding the creation of these structures as well as their subsequent abandonment The text is accompanied by archival photographs plans and images of the present condition of these structures *A + U, architecture and urbanism* ,2004 *Art and Revolution in Latin America, 1910-1990* David Craven,2006-01-01 In this uniquely wide ranging book David Craven investigates the extraordinary impact of three Latin American revolutions on the visual arts and on cultural policy The three great upheavals in Mexico 1910 40 in Cuba 1959 89 and in Nicaragua 1979 90 were defining moments in twentieth century life in the Americas Craven discusses the structural logic of each movement s artistic project by whom how and for whom artworks were produced and assesses their legacies In each case he demonstrates how the consequences of the revolution reverberated in the arts and cultures far beyond national borders The book not only examines specific artworks originating from each revolution s attempt to deal with the challenge of socializing the arts but also the engagement of the working classes in Mexico Cuba and Nicaragua with a tradition of the fine arts made newly accessible through social transformation Craven considers how each revolution dealt with the pressing problem of creating a dialogical art one that reconfigures the existing artistic resource rather than one that just reproduces a populist art to keep things as they were In addition the author charts the impact on the revolutionary processes of theories of art and education articulated by such thinkers as John Dewey and Paulo Freire The book provides a fascinating new view of the Latin American revolutionaries from artists to political leaders who defined art as a fundamental force for the transformation of society and who bequeathed new ways of
