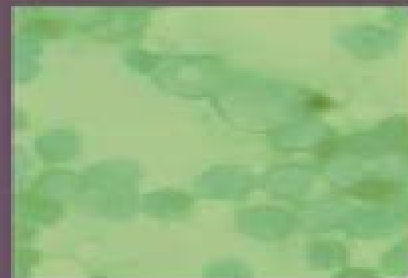

Persons involved in biomedical investigations must be competent. Although the requirements for practical training are being regulated to meet these demands in several countries, most courses are at a basic level and fail to deal with more detailed issues in their respective fields. There is a need to develop opportunities for more advanced training. Additionally, the literature has tremendous gaps which must be filled by special research projects. The emphasis of the atlas is placed on providing researchers with effective and practical information on discrimination of cellular morphology in rat hematology. The rat has in the past and currently been a major contributor to the advancement of biological science.
