	Engage: Activating Strategy/Hook: • Show students video “Ice Melting on Different Surfaces” (http://www.middlesexmiddlechemistry.com/files/chapter2/lesson5/ice_melting_on_different_surfaces). This video shows two cubes of ice on a hot plate. One cube is melting while the other is not. Following the clip, have students respond to the following writing prompt (also saved as a PPt: “What can you infer about this experiment? How does this relate to states of matter?” • Discuss student observations. Where do you think the energy came from to melt the ice? What do you think happened to the speed of the molecules when the ice was heated? • Distribute activity sheets (http://www.middlesexmiddlechemistry.com/files/chapter2/lesson5/5e3) • Give students time to answer first 2 questions of this activity sheet.
