Stein,2015-10-27 From 1850 to 1854 the ambitious Commander Robert McClure captained the HMS Investigator on a voyage in search of the missing Franklin Expedition which sailed from England into the Arctic in 1845 to map the last uncharted section of the North West Passage The Investigator and her consort the Enterprise were to pass through the Bering Strait from the west but a Pacific storm separated them never to meet again Obsessed with traversing the passage McClure pressed on and HMS Investigator spent three years trapped in pack ice in Mercy Bay before the crew abandoned ship on foot This book chronicles the voyage in detail McClure and his relationships with his officers are at the heart of the story of the arduous journey vividly illustrated by the paintings of Lt Samuel Cresswell **Unravelling the Franklin Mystery** David C. Woodman,1992-06 David Woodman s reconstruction of the mysterious events surrounding the disappearance of two British exploration vessels in 1845 under the command of Sir John Franklin challenges standard interpretations and promises to replace them Among the many who have tried to discover the truth behind the Franklin

disaster Woodman recognizes the profound importance of the Inuit testimony and analyzes it in depth He concludes from his investigations that the Inuit probably did visit Franklin s ships while the crew was still on board and that there were some Inuit who actually saw the sinking of one of the ships He maintains that fewer than ten bodies were found at Starvation Cove and that the last survivors left the cove in 1851 three years after the standard account assumes them to be dead Woodman also disputes the conclusion of Owen Beattie and John Geiger s book *Frozen in Time* that lead poisoning was a major contributing cause of the disaster

Hunters at the Margin John Sandlos,2011-11-01 *Hunters at the Margin* examines the conflict in the Northwest Territories between Native hunters and conservationists over three big game species the wood bison the muskox and the caribou John Sandlos argues that the introduction of game regulations national parks and game sanctuaries was central to the assertion of state authority over the traditional hunting cultures of the Dene and Inuit His archival research undermines the assumption that conservationists were motivated solely by enlightened preservationism revealing instead that commercial interests were integral to wildlife management in Canada

Red Serge and Polar Bear Pants William Barr,2004-12-20 This is the biography of an exceptional Canadian who as a member of the RCMP played a crucial role in asserting Canada s sovereignty in the Arctic Having emigrated to Canada from England in 1913 Harry Stallworthy joined the Force in 1914 and until 1921 served at various detachments in the Yukon except for the period 1918 19 when he participated in the RNWMP s Cavalry Detachment as part of the Canadian Expeditionary Force during the final bloody months of World War I in Flanders After serving for two years at Chesterfield Inlet west shore of Hudson Bay he was posted to Edmonton and while there contracted influenza which developed into pneumonia and very nearly killed him After

two years in Jasper where he met his future wife Hilda Austin the school principal for two years he served at the new RCMP post at Stony Rapids in Northern Saskatchewan In 1930 he went north for a two year posting at Bache Peninsula Ellesmere Island one of the three posts established to assert Canadian sovereignty in the uninhabited High Arctic While there in 1932 he mounted one of the longest and most dangerous sledge patrols in the history of the Force in search of the missing German geologist Hans Krueger In 1933 the resupply ship was unable to reach Bache Peninsula due to ice conditions and hence the two year posting stretched to three years On Stallworthy's return south in the fall of 1933 he and Hilda got married after an almost complete separation of five years In the light of his experience on Ellesmere Island Harry was next seconded to the Oxford University Ellesmere Land Expedition organized by Eddie Shackleton son of Sir Ernest Shackleton for 1934-35 During this operation Harry sledged to Lake Hazen Ellesmere Island the farthest north point ever reached by an RCMP officer on sledge patrol Thereafter Harry served at various posts in southern Canada with the exception of a few years at Fort Smith during World War II He retired in 1946 after which he and Hilda built and ran a small tourist resort Timberlane near Campbell River on Vancouver Island In 1954 Harry came out of retirement briefly to assume the position of head of security on the eastern half of the DEW Line He was presented with the Order of Canada by Queen Elizabeth in 1973 and died at his home in Comox B.C. on Christmas Day 1976 *Information Bulletin*, 1948 **Narrative of a Second Voyage in Search of a North-west Passage, and of a Residence in the Arctic Regions During the Years 1829-1830-1831-1832-1833** John Ross, 1835 *Narrative of a Second Voyage in search of a North-West Passage, etc. [With maps.]* Sir John Ross, 1835
