Harry Morgan, with whose life this novel is entirely concerned, is perhaps the most completely real masculine character that Ernest Hemingway has created.

Morgan is a native of Key West, Florida — that paradise of the "haves" and purgatory of the "have nots." He owns a fast motor boat in which he takes out fishing parties, runs rum, guns and sometimes human contraband. His life is a lonely struggle to keep himself, his wife, and daughters away from the edge of the "have not" category. His friends see him as a man of no pity, least of all for himself. All his life he has played a lone hand in a hard world and it is only in the climax of the novel, as moving a scene as Mr. Hemingway has ever written, that he realizes the failure of his philosophy. The reader sees him in the round — through his own words and thoughts, through the eyes of Albert, the friend Harry Morgan unwittingly sends to his death, through

To Have and Have Not Ernest Hemingway, 1937 **Little Dorrit** Charles Dickens, 2020-06-20 *Little Dorrit* is a novel by Charles Dickens originally published in serial form between 1855 and 1857 The story features Amy Dorrit youngest child of her family born and raised in the Marshalsea prison for debtors in London Arthur Clennam encounters her after returning home from a 20 year absence ready to begin his life anew The novel satirises the shortcomings of both government and society including the institution of debtors prisons where debtors were imprisoned unable to work until they repaid their debts The prison in this case is the Marshalsea where Dickens own father had been imprisoned Dickens is also critical of the lack of a social safety net the treatment and safety of industrial workers as well as the bureaucracy of the British Treasury in the form of his fictional Circumlocution Office In addition he satirises the stratification of society that results from the British class system
