The Church of England is a group of churches and is part of a Christian denomination (group) known as the Anglican Communion, which has churches around the world. Its most senior religious leader is the Archbishop of Canterbury.

The United Kingdom's monarch is the Supreme Governor (or Head) of the Church of England.

Early Christianity in Britain

In 497, Saint Augustine arrived in Britain to establish Christianity. Soon after, he founded a church in Canterbury which became a cathedral and the seat of the Archbishop of Canterbury. It was part of the Roman Catholic Church, based in Rome, Italy.

Martin Luther and the English Reformation



During the 16th century, many people were critical of the Roman Catholic Church. One complaint was that everything was in Latin; most people couldn't understand it.

In 1517, a monk named Martin Luther nailed 95 points against Rome on a church door in Germany. His words spread throughout Europe and started a change known as the Reformation. Many people became Protestants.

Henry VIII and the English Reformation



In the 1530s, Henry VIII broke away from Rome because it would not allow his marriage to Katherine of Aragon. He was named the Supreme Head of the Church of England.
