Strengths and weaknesses of the behaviourist approach:

The strength of behaviourist approach is that it is based on observing the individuals which is seen to be an easier method of collecting data and then deciding on the conclusions. It is said to provide clear evidence and explanations on that particular topic of research. Most of the scientists are able to present their results with their observations and measures. It is positively more economic than carrying out experiments with genes and DNA where you would need a whole laboratory, a scientist Pavlov was able to carry out his experiment at home, however, he needed a machine to record and calculate the amount of saliva his dog produced when he rang the bell. It wasn't a very cost consuming experiment, however, it did support a lot of results and backed up the entire hypothesis that he had.

One other strength is that Pavlov managed to link his experiment to the objective of the scientific approach psychology where he studied he behaviour of his dog. He was able to directly measure his results which were very accurate and then record them for later use throughout the experiment. The observations are more effective than opinions as they actually provide and prove scientific hypothesis which could be used to compare the results and obtain a final conclusion.

A weakness of this approach is that it is focused too much on the nurture which is how the environment affects the behaviour of the individuals who are being observed. The psychologists usually ignore any resemblance with the genes or any scientific perspectives when it comes to collecting data. As well as, any emotions that the individual is experiencing such as motivation are not considered in the experiment data to support the theory. There are suggestions that the behaviour is caused by stimuli and their response in particular situations. The behaviour is caused by the personalities and learning capabilities.

Strengths and weaknesses of the social learning theory

Bandura's findings have shown that children have imitated aggression if something aggressive has been shown to them. There was a study where a child was watching an adult bash and afterwards the child would aggressively play with a doll, this continued till the child has been punished and the movie was confiscated.

The strength of the theory is that Bandura discovered that although someone watched or plays video games they don't actually think about them unless a nerve in their brain is triggered which causes them to act that way. The behaviour of the individual is not altered even if the person learns something new. It is said that the people that commit crime still act the same way they did the night before without anything influencing them.

Another strength is that the behaviour of the individual could be used in a positive way because the children could get motivated to imitate the behaviour that could impact them positively, they are more likely to do something good if they receive some kind of praise or reward if they do something well. There is a benefit in that because there is a point where a role model is not needed anymore which means that the individual could go by themselves and still have a positive attitude and behaviour. People who have a positive attitude are more likely to perform better in school and are more likely to be successful due to motivation to succeed and get a good job.
