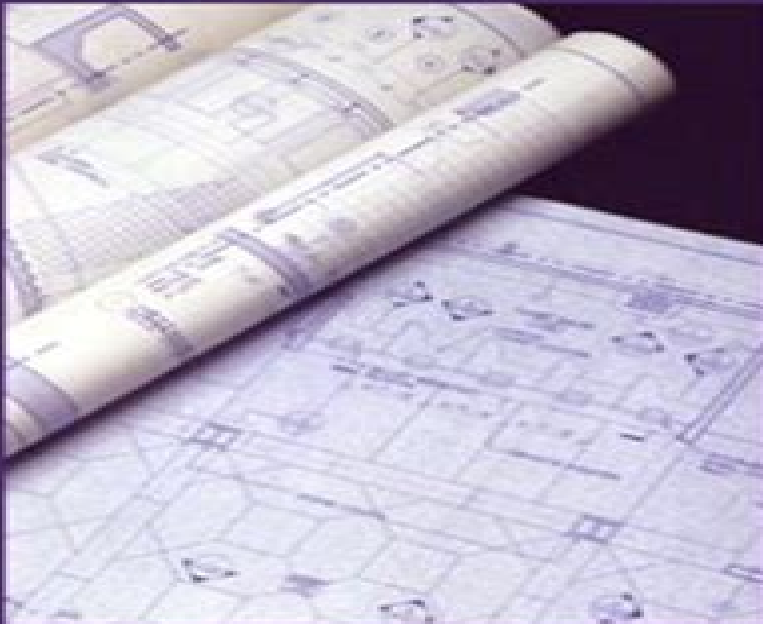

redundancy yet it allows lecturers and their students to either use the book as the basis of teaching software architecture or design or to just pick those aspects that need special attention in a more advanced course
