**American Plains Bison** James Allen Bailey, 2013 For many plains bison are the embodiment of wildness and the pre settlement American West After millennia of evolution through natural selection however the species was nearly wiped out only to be subjected to domestication for more than 100 years Domestication alters the bison genome through inbreeding crossing with cattle genes shrinking genetic diversity and artificial selection These forces continue to replace natural selection and valued wild characteristics of bison Does the future hold only continued domestication for plains bison in the United States With a view from over 50 years in the profession of wildlife biology Bailey probes this and other questions in *The American Plains Bison Rewilding an Icon* The book presents his original and lively analysis of 44 conservation bison herds on native range in the United States He focuses upon the gray area between wildness and domestication and sheds light on domesticating practices of Native American and government agencies as well as commercial bison producers He challenges the profession of wildlife management to expand its views on manipulating wildlife populations For bison Bailey makes a strong case for creating large reserves to restore wild bison and their natural contributions to our grassland ecosystems

**The Essence of Wildness** James a Bailey,2016-09-02 In a previous book American Plains Bison Rewilding An Icon Bailey pondered the issue of domestic vs wild bison He concludes wildness is more than a mere romantic notion and provides a definition of wildness based on population genetics and evolutionary biology

Degree of wildness depends upon the preponderance of natural selection a criterion that is measurable and operational in the practice of wildlife management Bailey contends wildness may be the most ignored characteristic of wildlife unrecognized in most wildlife law and little considered in much management

With an emphasis on large mammals he notes twelve categories of common management practices that weaken or replace natural selection Bailey intends to communicate an academic topic to most owners of American wildlife anyone who has had one good biology class

He discusses the sources of genetic diversity in wildlife populations and the selective and random processes that may alter population genetics He then illustrates these interactions noting how natural selection for wildness may be replaced or weakened especially in populations that are not

large or do not exist in large diverse habitats Bailey concludes with a plea for more and better examples of wildness amongst the increasingly domesticated environments of North America Jim Bailey was professor of wildlife biology at Colorado State University for 20 years His first book was Principles of Wildlife Management His recent book on American Plains Bison led to a reassessment of wildlife management's influences upon wildness in large mammals ideas explored more fully in The Essence of Wildness
